





Since the first batch of co-educational students in 2000, the number of students going on to four-year universities, including national and public universities, has increased. The school has grown steadily as an academic-track school, and has been designated as a "higher education guidance school" in Fukushima Prefecture. In particular, among national and public universities, such as local Fukushima University, there are many successful applicants, mainly from universities in the Tohoku and Kanto regions, including the University of Aizu and Fukushima Medical University. In addition, they have passed the entrance exam for universities with a high degree of difficulty, such as Tohoku University.

## To Realize Students' Own Dreams

#### 1 University Tour

Students participate in open campuses such as Tohoku University, Niigata University, etc. and research about Faculties and departments.

#### 2 Diverse Career Lectures

The school conducts on-site lectures by university professors and lectures by business people to raise awareness of career paths.

#### 3 Exchange meeting with alumni

Through lectures by current university students and successful applicants, students will think more closely and realistically about going on to university.

### Ability training

#### 1 Long-term extracurricular

This course is held during long vacations for all grades to develop the ability to go on to university.

#### 2 Normal extracurricular

In order to prepare for entrance exams for third-year students, after-school courses are held upon request.

#### 3 Saturdays extracurricular

Courses will be held in all grades to improve expansive academic ability.

#### 4 Essay Course

In order to develop the required "reading comprehension", "thinking abilities", and "expressive abilities", systematic lectures and mock exams will be held from the first year.

#### 5 Nationwide Mock test

All grades regularly take national mock exams to test their abilities. In addition, the school strengthens students' weak points by enriching the review after taking the exam.

#### 6 Enhancement of individual instruction

We will enhance correction guidance and interview preparation guidance. In addition, individual interviews are conducted in detail to support career realization.

### All students take external English proficiency tests

At our school, all 1st and 2nd year students take Eiken at school in January.

**1st year students aim to acquire the pre-2nd grade, and 2nd year students aim to acquire the 2nd grade.**

Taking Eiken strengthens the motivation to learn English, which leads to improvement in English academic ability. In addition, in recent years, the number of universities using external English proficiency tests for entrance examinations has increased rapidly, and 25% of our last year's graduates went on to four-year universities such as Fukushima University, Ibaraki University, etc. using the English proficiency test score.



### With relaxed school style, there is a fulfilling high school life in studying, sports, and cultural activities.

It was founded as Koriyama Practical Girls' School in 1923. In 1948, it was renamed Fukushima Prefectural Koriyama Women's East School. It has embodied the spirit of "Shukutoku" since its establishment, and has sent out many people who contribute to the community. It has been reborn as an ordinary high school for co-education since 1998, and the school will celebrate the 100th anniversary of our founding in the year 2023. It has achieved steady results every year in students advancing to national and public universities, but it has also focused on club activities, and participated in national competitions every year. In order to enhance students' high school life and realize their career hopes, the school will develop new classes that incorporate exploration activities, focus on school events and volunteer activities, and walk its own path as Koriyama East High School.

## Facilities and Equipment

The library has recently been refurbished and now offers a state-of-the-art library and audio-visual room. Each classroom is air-conditioned, and students can study hard in a comfortable environment, including the study room. In addition, regular classrooms for all grades are equipped with projectors, magnetic screens, and Wi-Fi. Classes are conducted to enhance the ability to think, judge, and express one's self. Baseball, soccer, and softball teams practice on the 1st ground. There are four tennis courts, two handball courts, and an archery range on the 2nd ground.
